Football, rugby, hockey have a referee but tennis, cricket and baseball have an umpire. In football the referee has a whistle to control the game and two linesmen. In tennis there are line judges to decide if the ball is 'in' or 'out'. For most ball games you need boots or training shoes (trainers). For tennis, squash and badminton you need a racket. For baseball and table tennis you need a bat. For golf you need clubs. In tennis, volleyball and badminton there is a net across the middle of the court. There is also a net around each goal in football.

05.05	Holidays in Kazakhstan1	<p>January 1-2, New YearKazakhstan began celebrating the New Year in accordance with European traditions while under Russian rule in the mid-19th century, and today it is one of the country's most beloved holidays.In Kazakhstan, the heroes of New Year are Ayaz Ata (Santa Claus) and his granddaughter Qar Qız (Snow Girl). Together they deliver bags of gifts and plenty of cheer to homes and schoolrooms across the country. Long after children grow into adults, the magic created for them by parents and relatives over the New Year remains etched in their minds as they recreate a festive atmosphere for the next generation. At midnight on December 31st, people welcome the New Year with exuberant words of congratulations accompanied by ample fireworks, heartfelt toasts and mouthwatering feasts shared with family and friends. Although traditionally a family holiday, some residents of Kazakhstan's larger cities now prefer to spend New Year's Eve at special events held in many restaurants and bars</p>
